COLLECT AND RECYCLE CANS AND BOTTLES

With Victoria's Container Deposit Scheme (CDS Vic)

The scheme gives Victorians a 10-cent refund for every eligible can, carton and bottle they return with the option to donate the money to the Good Friday Appeal.

- Draw up a budget to help keep track of costs

AUTHORITY TO FUNDRAISE

To meet our obligations under Fundraising Laws, for all in person events all fundraisers must complete our fundraising registration form and agree to our Terms and Conditions. Applications are reviewed by our Fundraising Team and an Authority to Fundraise certificate will be issued once approved.

RAFFLES

One of the most effective ways to raise funds can be through raffles. If your raffle has a total prize pool of under \$5000, then you won't need a permit to run it. If the prize pool is \$5000 and over, the Victorian Government requires you to apply for a minor gaming permit.

HEALTH AND SAFETY RESPONSIBILITIES

We are always thankful to our fundraisers and donors, which is why your safety and wellbeing is a top priority. Please ensure you read over and adhere to your relevant council's health and safety laws and guidelines and COVID-safe procedures when organising your event.



PERMITS AND INSURANCE

Please keep in mind things like:

- Public Liability Insurance check with your venue if your event is covered under their policy or whether you will need to obtain one yourself.
- Your local council laws check whether a permit is required to hold an event and whether a Food Handling Certificate is required if you are selling food.
